TOURNAMENT/ROUND-UP RULES

1. Entry Fee will be \$40.00 cash per team or individual, 100% Payout - Five Heaviest fish - Big Fish - By Weight **each team or individual must have five snakeheads to qualify.**
2. **Boat & Cooler Check at mornings registration any snakeheads in possession will result in disqualification.**
3. Artificial Lures only, minimum length 10 inches
4. Feeding locations are off limits, if caught team/person will be disqualified.
5. Looking in other anglers coolers during Round Up hours will result in Disqualification.
6. Participants must be 18 years or older or fishing with parental supervision through the duration of round up hours.
7. All contestants must check in at registration the morning of the tournament BEFORE 6:00 a.m. Entrance fee will be collected the morning of tournament payable in CASH ONLY.
8. The official tournament waters are all bodies of water that can be legally fished, fish at your own risk.
9. Safe boating - Each competitor is required to wear a Coast Guard approved flotation life vest securely fastened whenever the combustion engine is running.
10. **All competitors are expected to show courtesy to all persons.** Drunkenness will not be tolerated. No alcoholic beverages or other stimulants are allowed during Round Up hours.
11. No competitor shall have a non-competitor "sit on a hole", spot or scout for them.
12. Any and all protests must be made prior to awards being announced in writing and signed by the competitors making the protest. **Once awards are made the results are final.**
13. **This is a rod and reel only event.** no cast netting, bow and Arrows, explosives, electric shock fishing will be allowed.
14. Each motorized boat must have a kill switch.
15. All persons must check in by appointed time, 10 minutes late is total disqualification. There will be no check-ins before 1:30pm Check-in time may be changed by director at blast off.
16. In the event of a tie the team that has the next heaviest fish will break the tie.
17. Interpretation of these rules shall be left exclusively to the tournament officials, decisions of the officials are final.
