TOURNAMENT/ROUND-UP RULES

1. Entry Fee will be \$40.00 per two person team. 100% Payout - \$10.00 additional dollars for Big Fish pot. 1st, 2nd & 3rd Places - 50/30/20 Split: **If ten teams or more.** Big Fish - By Length measurement & Who has killed the most snakeheads.
2. Participants must be 18 years or older or parental supervision.
3. All contestants must check in at registration the morning of the tournament BEFORE 6:15 a.m. Entries will be collected the morning if tournament payable in CASH ONLY.
4. The official tournament waters are all bodies if water that can be legally be fished.
5. Safe boating must be observed at all times. Each competitor is required to WEAR a Coast Guard approved flotation life vest securely fastened whenever the combustion engine is running.
6. All competitors are expected to show courtesy to all persons on the water. Drunkenness will not be tolerated. No alcoholic beverages or other stimulants are allowed. No competitor shall have a non-competitor "sit on a hole", spot or scout for them.
7. Protests must be filed in writing and signed by the competitors making the protest. Protest must be made before the awards are made. Once awards are made the results are finale.
8. Each competitor agrees by signing the application form to submit to a polygraph examination if requested by tournament officials.
9. All Snakeheads must be taken in a legal manner.
10. Each motorized boat must have a kill switch.
11. All persons must check in by appointed time, 15 minutes late is total disqualification. There will be no check-ins before 2:30 p.m. Check-in time may be changed by director at blast off.
12. In the event of a tie the team that has the larger amount of Bigger fish will break the tie, Big Fish tie will be determined in the same manner.
13. Interpretation of these rules shall be left exclusively to the tournament officials. Decisions of the officials are FINAL. Infraction of these rules is grounds for disqualification from this & future tournaments/round-ups.
